



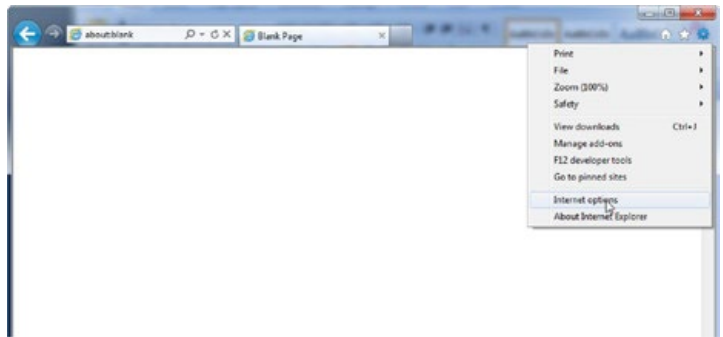

STEP ONE

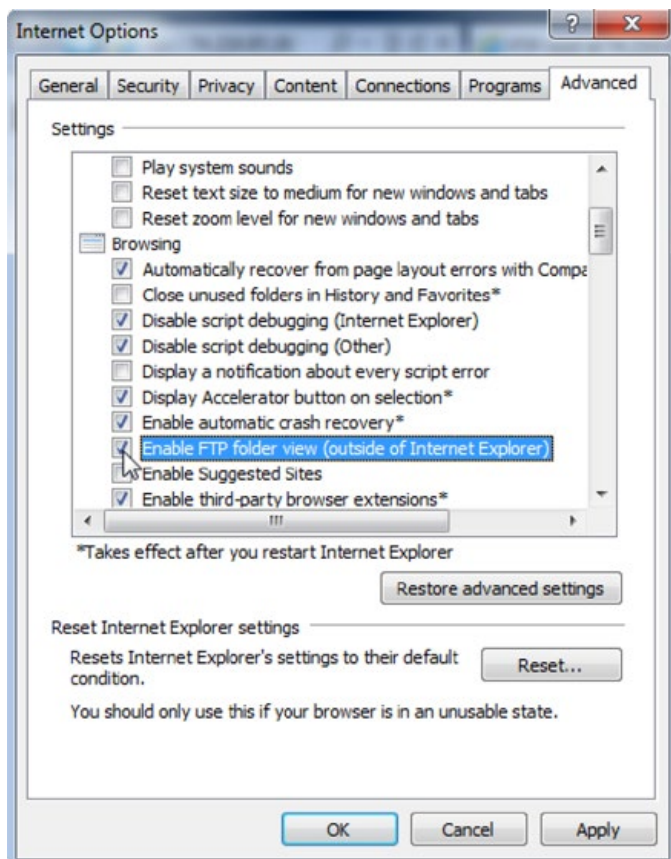
To use the Digital Fringe FTP site, go into Internet Explorer and put in the URL <ftp://74.218.85.18>

First time users (with Windows, we are still confirming a few things on Mac) will probably need to confirm a couple of Internet Explorer options. You get to them through the **'Gear'** icon or **'Tools'** at the tool bar and then **'Internet Options'** from the menu:



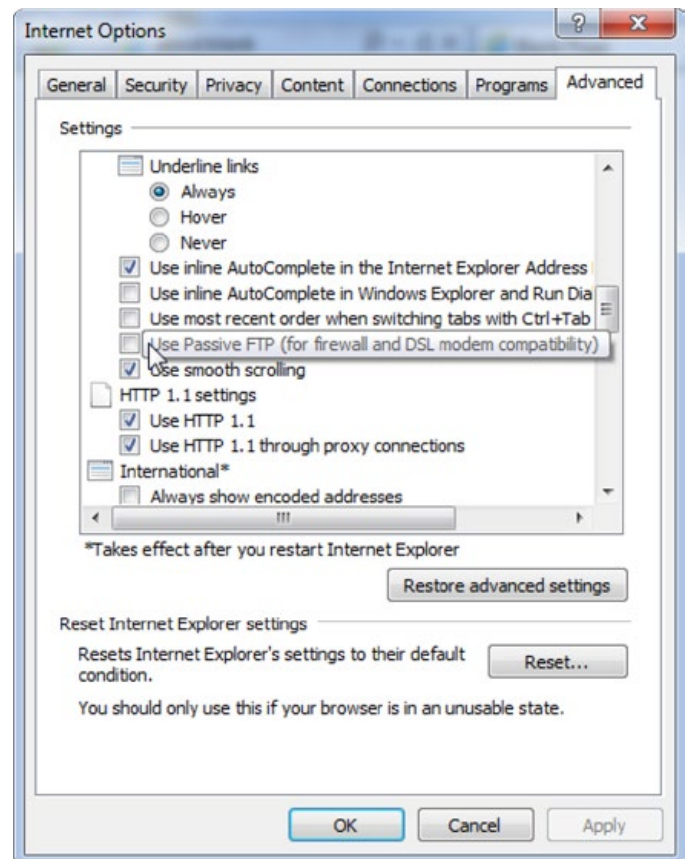
STEP TWO

Under the Advanced tab scroll down and check **'Enable FTP Folder View'**:



STEP THREE

Scroll down farther and uncheck the **'Use Passive FTP'** box before proceeding:



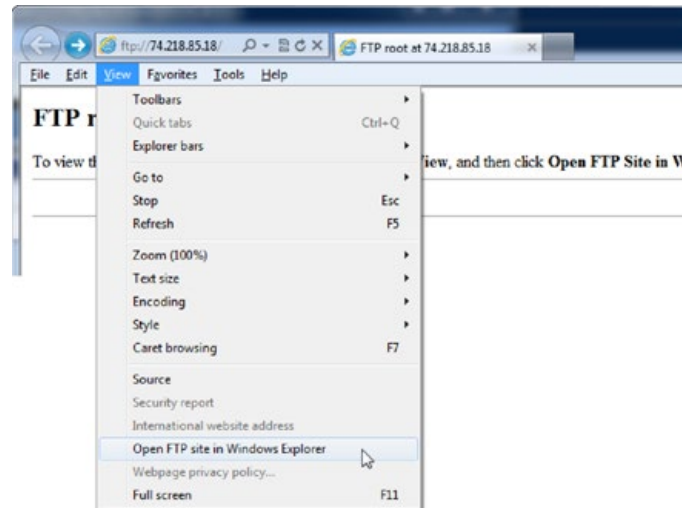
STEP FOUR

When you go to it ([URL ftp://74.218.85.18](ftp://74.218.85.18)) it will look like this:



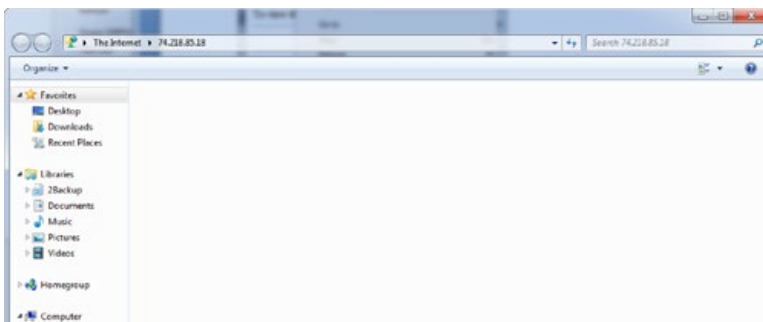
STEP FIVE

Press Alt, click View, and Open FTP Site in Windows Explorer to be able to copy files to the site:



STEP SIX

Then you are ready to drag and drop files as if it were another directory on your local computer or network. You can also create a directory to segregate you files.
